INU Masters Program...

The INU recognises that internationalization is vital to developing students' knowledge of leadership, citizenship and cross cultural understanding, which have become essential skills in our Global Society. Through innovative program development, the INU has established a Master's Program on Global Citizenship and Peace at 7 of the 11 member institutions incorporating flexibility for student mobility.

Double Degrees...

An exciting feature of the INU Masters in Global Citizenship and Peace is the opportunity to enrol in one of the INU Masters Double Degree Programs. Students can enhance their MA program by spending a year abroad researching in the fields related to "Global Citizenship and Peace," by majoring and gaining a degree in such areas as International Relations, Development, Human Rights, Ethnic & Immigration, and Peace, exploring new cultures, and gaining invaluable knowledge through these experiences.

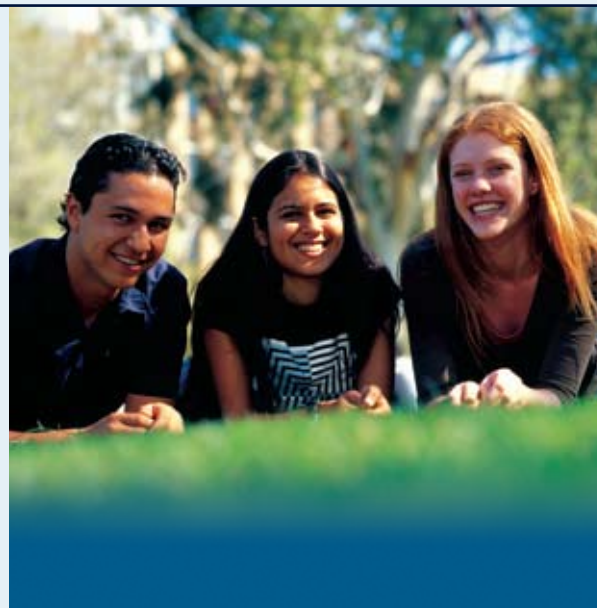
Benefits...

- **Receive 2 Degrees:** Students successfully completing the program earn two degrees: one Masters degree from their home institution and one from the host institution.
- **Cost Effective:** Students pay their home tuition fees whilst at the overseas institution.
- **Gain Competitive Advantage:** Students will differentiate themselves from other MA students and gain a competitive edge in the Marketplace
- **Experience New Cultures:** Students personally grow by experiencing a new culture and learning environment.

Program Details

Graduate students enrolled in an INU Double Degree Program have the opportunity to gain a Masters degree from their home institution and the host institution simultaneously.

- Students study a minimum 1 year abroad at an INU partner institution
- Credit gained from the overseas institution is counted towards student's degree at the home institution with an upper limit set by each institution's respective academic regulations
- Students select from a diverse range of research areas that could include: International Relations, Human Rights, Peace, Immigration, and Development
- Tuition fees are paid only to the home institution - fees are not applicable at the overseas study abroad institution
- All Programs are conducted in English
